

After passing along Dverce Street next to the Lotrscak Guard Tower you shall come to a crossroads where the Baroque St Catherine's Church is situated on Katarina Zrinski Square. The Church was consecrated in the 15th Century by the Dominicans and taken over by the Jesuits in the 17th Century. The arrival of the Jesuits led to a period of literacy for the local population, construction of their Monastery (today's Gallery Klovićevi dvori) and the new Baroque St Catherine's Church. They also built the first gimnazija (grammar school) in Zagreb (today's Gornjogradska gimnazija). The Croatian nobility often attended the Church and presented it with valuable gifts, and the Erdödy Family were known to be especially generous. In turn, these benefactors were buried inside the Church.

Head straight down Ćirilometodska Street (Gospodska or the Noble Street) where you will find the next QR code waiting on the pavement next to St. Mark's Square
